

## 1996 Cabernet Sauvignon

### **Winemaker Notes:**

A wine possessing beautiful deep red color, Leonetti's '96 Cabernet Sauvignon has a nose that reflects spices of cedar and mint, bursting with plum, cherry, and cassis fruits. The expansive mouth feel and well integrated tannins define a soft, fleshy and balanced cabernet sauvignon. There's loads of complexity showing in this multi-layered beauty.

Bacchus Vineyard (Sagemoor Farms) and Conner-Lee Vineyards, of Columbia Valley; Otis Vineyards and Brulotte Vineyards, Yakima Valley; Pepper Bridge Farms and Seven Hills Vineyard of Walla Walla Valley, and Ristow Vineyard of Napa Valley (34%).
