

## **Leonetti Cellar**

1998 Sangiovese  
Walla Walla Valley

Produced from the nearly perfect growing season of 1998, our Sangiovese Walla Walla Valley is a dark ruby wine with an incredible nose of balsam, ripe cherry, and spice. The palate impression is soft and gratifying, accentuated by crisp acidity and integrated oak flavors followed by a lingering finish. Although our Sangiovese is always very food-friendly, We feel that this wine can stand alone against any Sangiovese-based wine produced in the world today.

### Vineyards in this Wine

Pepper Bridge Farms, Spring Valley Vineyards, Seven Hills Vineyard and Leonetti Estate Vineyard, all of Walla Walla Valley.

### Blending Detail

Sangiovese 76.5%, Syrah 15.7%, Petit Verdot 3.9%, Cabernet Sauvignon 3.9%.

### Oak Aging Profile

This wine was aged in a mix of new American and French oak barrels.

### Production of this Wine

Six hundred and thirty-five cases.
